


Where it all began



2,500 additional HFC leaders will receive catechism training through regional seminars and special courses held at the facility in Hanoi







The new facility would include a worship space, dormitories and kitchen facilities for 60 people, ministry offices for leaders of the HFC, and classrooms





Operational costs will include salaries, living and travel costs for rural church leaders, and travel expenses for regional seminars throughout Vietnam
