



Rev. Dr. Michael Hartman leads church planting efforts in the United Kingdom, focusing on London and international ministry. With a team of volunteers and a core group of members, exploratory work is being carried out with the goal of establishing a hub church in London and a network of smaller groups in the area and beyond. Missionary Hartman works with individuals who have connections around the world, ranging from Africa and South America to Europe and Asia.

Prior to serving in the UK, Missionary Hartman led the Latin American mission team to bring the gospel to the Spanish-speaking world and equip leaders with resources to form churches. God used him to found Academia Cristo, a Spanish language Bible Institute and church planting ministry. Today, Academia Cristo has more than 2 million followers on social media channels, over 700 students are active in the program, and 39 have been called to plant churches in their communities.

Missionary Hartman graduated from the Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary and has a Doctor of Ministry in church planting. He currently lives in London with his wife Rachel and their four children.
