Rev. Guy Marquardt serves as the director of the Regional Theological Education Program and as a professor at Asia Lutheran Seminary. He also serves oversees exploratory work for the Asia One Team and is the liaison with partners in Myanmar and the Philippines He and his wife Linda live in Chiang Mai, Thailand, as empty nesters.

Marquardt was first assigned from Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary in 1994 as a church planter in southern Brazil.
